Dear Parent/Carer,

We wish everyone a very warm welcome back to a new school year. We are looking forward to working in partnership with you to make it a truly memorable one.

Congratulations on how smartly turned out the children are for the new school year. They are a credit to you. They came through the gates with enthusiasm on Wednesday morning and have settled in well to their new classes. We are sure that this enthusiasm and energy continues for the challenges that they will meet this year.

There is good news to share about Mr McQueen. He is out of theatre and now beginning his recovery. I know many of you have been asking about him and I will send on your good wishes. We will miss him and yet all do our best to ensure we maintain the high standards he has set for Ursuline. We pray for his speedy recovery.

There is a change to the reward system, which we have been planning for a while now, and thought it best to start at this point. Children will be earning Golden Time, not losing it. They can earn 1 minute towards Golden Time at each session including breaks and lunchtimes. They can earn up to 6 minutes a day which will amount to 30 minutes Golden Time on Fridays. If there is a misdemeanour they will not get that minute for that particular session. The children will be given 2 warnings. If the behaviour continues after that, they are told that they have not earned it for the session. There will <u>not</u> be an opportunity to earn it back. We have explained this to the children.
